Underground S-Bahn stations to be modernised by 2021

Information on construction-related station closures

For a more pleasant travel experience in a more contemporary ambience, DB Station&Service AG will be modernising the following S-Bahn stations that have passed their prime: München Hbf, Karlsplatz (Stachus), Marienplatz, Isartor and Rosenheimer Platz. Most of the work will be done during the night hours from 10 pm to 6 am in order to minimise any inconvenience. Even so, it is not possible to entirely eliminate such inconveniences in a project of this scale. There will be a total of twelve weekends (six in 2019 and six in 2020) on which the Munich core route will be either partially or entirely closed to permit work around the clock. There will also be days on which trains will not stop at these stations, however, in each of these cases, only one direction of travel will be affected.

There are five weekend closings scheduled for 2019 (four in August and one in October) on the core route, as well as additional days when trains do not stop at individual platforms.

S-Bahn München will offer you an effective replacement service during these times. Detailed information on the aforementioned construction work and resulting changes to schedules can be found online at **s-bahn-muenchen.de/baustellen**
